<b>Position Overview</b>	Equipment Operators are responsible for the safe operation, maintenance and service of motorized vehicles and equipment as well as performing manual labour in all weather conditions. Equipment Operators assist in a variety of tasks related to inspecting and maintaining parks, sports fields and roads. Duties may include, but are not limited to, grass cutting and trimming, turf aeration, general maintenance such as litter and debris pick-up from parks and roadsides, and emptying waste receptacles.
<b>Responsibilities</b>	<p>The Roads, Parks and Forestry Department is recruiting for multiple Equipment Operators for parks, turf and sports field maintenance activities. Work is checked and reviewed for performance. In addition to the above, the following is an overview of responsibilities as it relates to the district it will be located within :</p> <p>Equipment Operators report to the Supervisors of Parks and will perform such activities as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Monitor sports field use and operation of field lights</li><li>• Check sports field user permits</li><li>• Perform minor parks maintenance and repairs</li><li>• Open, close, inspect and clean public washroom facilities</li><li>• Pick litter and empty garbage receptacles from parks, playground, parking lots, and roadsides etc.</li><li>• Operate city vehicles and equipment such as pickup trucks, mowers and tractors, and other related small and large equipment, including attachments, as required</li></ul>
<b>Requirements</b>	The successful candidates will ideally have a minimum high school diploma and 1-2 years demonstrated equipment experience related to duties. Demonstrated effective communications, both oral and written, along with customer service and problem-solving skills. Proficient time management skills and flexibility in adjusting between a variety of duties. Ability to work with minimal supervision and as part of a team. A valid driver's license, with a good driving record is required, with a DZ license considered an asset. Must be able to perform physical work, willing to be on-call and able to work various shifts throughout the season.
